<b>GAP Funding</b>	Albion Borough was awarded \$760,000.00 through GAP Funding, this a no matching grant.

<b>AVFD</b>	The Borough will continue to pay the AVFD utilities at 15 Smock Avenue, but a 90 day notice will be given that the utilities at 26 Smock Avenue will no longer be paid by the Borough.
