Albion Volunteer Fire Department Multi-Municipal Emergency Services Commission Formed

*The Multi-Municipal Emergency Services Commission is made up by the following
Municipalities: Albion Borough, Conneaut Township, Cranesville Borough, and Elk Creek
Township. This Commission was created to help ensure the long-term sustainability of fire
and Emergency medical services for each Municipality.*

Each municipality is required to provide their residents with emergency services. The elected leaders of Albion Borough, Conneaut Township, Cranesville Borough, and Elk Creek Township formed the Multi-Municipal Emergency Services Commission. A resolution was passed by each municipality entering into an intergovernmental cooperation agreement for the specific purpose of ensuring the residents of each municipality continues to have the best possible fire and emergency services readily available. Staffing shortages, felt by volunteer fire departments nationwide, is a major concern and in the forefront of the Multi-Municipal Emergency Services Commission. Nicholas W. Sohyda, Fire Chief, CFO, EFO, and Consultant was hired by the Multi-Municipal Commission to help guide them on ways to help ensure emergency services will remain available to their residents.

Nicholas W. Sohyda is currently the fire chief of the Mt. Lebanon Fire Department located on Southwestern PA. Mr. Sohyda has served in numerous leadership roles both in volunteer and career fire service



organizations throughout his thirty-six-year fire service career. My Sohyda has provided fire service management and consulting services since 2007. Chief Sohyda will meet with the Multi-Municipality Commission and the local volunteer fire departments leaders to obtain more information from all parties involved.
