Albion Area Library Grant Awarded for \$335,205.00

Albion Librarian Erin Tate and Albion Borough Assistant Secretary/Treasurer Angela Telega worked together to apply for the LSA Statewide Program Grant through the PA Department of Community & Economic Development for our local library.

The first phase of the library building improvement project was started when the Albion Borough received a grant from the Erie County Gaming and Revenue Authority (ECGRA), and the Albion Area Public Library received a grant from the Erie Community Foundation. These grants were put together to contract the services of Surveyors and Architectural Engineers

to outline the areas of the building that needed addressing. Also, the first phase utilizes the ECGRA grant and the Keystone Grant for Public Libraries to start work on the handicap-accessible ramp at the rear of the building. By collaborating on a building improvement plan, the Albion Borough and Albion Area Public Library have started these project phases that encompass the

problems affecting the library and its ability to serve our community's needs continuously.
