We want to move forward to appoint Cranesville Volunteer Fire Department as the four municipalities fire responders and Albion would remain Albion Borough and Conneaut Townships EMS provider. AVFD would no longer be covered under the municipality's insurance for fire calls, only EMS calls. We recommend increasing taxes by 1 mil to cover the cost of paying the Cranesville Volunteer Fire Department.
